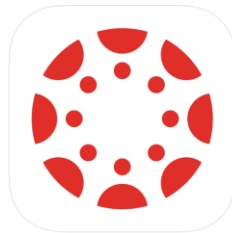
CANVAS STUDENT APP DOWNLOAD

When downloading ensure you download the student app which is identified with the red coloured icon below.

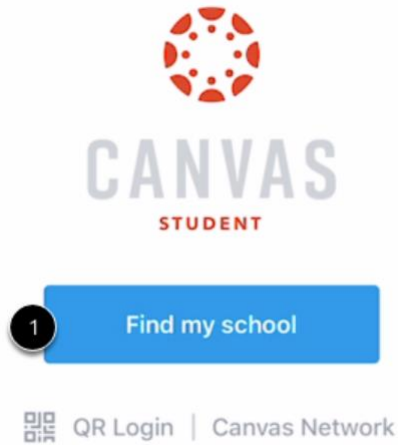


It is recommended that the latest version is always used and that the most recent version of IOS or Android is on the mobile devices.

HOW TO LOG IN TO THE STUDENT APP

The following procedure is only required for the first time that students log into the app.

1. Open the app
2. Click the find my school button [1]

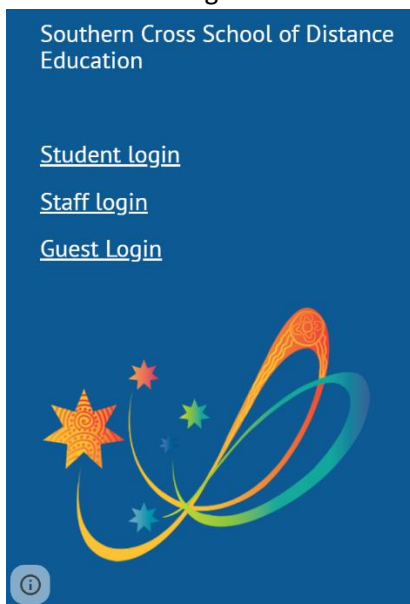


3. Search for your school by entering Southern Cross School Distance Education

What's your school's name?


Once you see the name of the school tap on this to select

4. Select student login from the menu displayed.




NOTE: Some students have been given a guest account so they will use this option.

5. You will be redirected to a Microsoft account and will need to enter your full school email. Students need to enter their email in the following format then select next;
- john.smith@education.nsw.gov.au

- The user ID is your email prefix that is before the @ symbol. If your email is john.smith12@education.nsw.edu.au, your User ID is john.smith12
